3. A service certificate showing the number of transfer during the preceding 7 years duly signed and Stamped by the head of office bearing the name, designation and other relevant particulars in block letters.
4. Mere registration will not confer a right to admission.
5. Incomplete application forms shall be rejected.

6. Admission secured on the basis of any wrong certificate shall be cancelled by the Principal forthwith and no appeal against such action of the Principal shall be entertained.
